SELECTION OF APPLICANT TO FULFILL TERM VACATED BY JAMES A. ZAVINSKI, SR.

Citizens who submitted the requisite application materials and in attendance were:

- 1. Angela Abreu
- 2. Douglas Hearn

Mayor Cashman stated that the order of the selection process would be:

- 1. Each applicant to be given the opportunity to make a statement to Council;
- 2. Council members to be given the opportunity to pose questions to the applicants;
- 3. Floor opened for nominations with no second to the nomination required (as in past practice); and
- 4. A roll call vote to be taken with the applicant receiving the requisite minimum of four votes to be named to fulfill Mr. Zavinski's term through January, 2022.
