A violation letter for a resident from Zoning was read and approved.

The COG membership ordinance was read. Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom made a motion to stay a member of the COG Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes. The secretary will find out when the township will have to adopt the Ordinance/ Resolution.

The township can apply for \$2,666.00 in Country Aid funds. Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom made a motion to use the county aid funds for HFMS-2 (E11-90) Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes. Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to sign resolution 2-2022 for the county aid allocation Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

The spring clean-up date was discussed. Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom made a motion to hold the spring clean-up on May 14th from 9-2 Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

The millage rate form was completed. Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom made a motion to sign the millage rate form Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

The American Rescue Plan funds were discussed. Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to use the funds towards the purchase of HFMS-2 (E11-90), 2RC, #8 anti-skid and to purchase a new computer for the township office Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes. The secretary will check with Bryan to see if he can help in the purchase of a new computer.

Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$7,523.49 from the General Fund Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:09 pm Supervisor Jeffrey Carlstrom seconds the motion. Motion carried with two votes.
