

Minutes of the February 1, 2021 Supervisors Meeting**Bills for Approval:**

Jeff Labesky present in regards to parking lots being made at Corner of Tan Street and Center Street and Horton Avenue.

Clarendon Borough received a letter from National Fuel Gas as well and also charges \$400 for road opening permits. Mead Township did not receive a letter and charges \$600 for road opening permits. Ordinance No. 120 was passed in April of 2002 establishing a fee of \$100 and an inspection fee of \$25. This was amended in 2008 raising the fee to \$400. Our solicitor has been given all this information, shall proceed with a response to this letter?

Tax Claim Bureau has received the following bids that we will need to approve:

- Ehrlich forwards us the vegetation management services proposal and agreement for the following areas in Sheffield Township:
 - 1x VMS of Knotweed patches at corner of 1st & 3rd Mill Street 200 sq feet \$195.00
 - 1x VMS SVC to begin at guardrail at Austin Hill Road & Corner of Keystone Avenue targeting approx. 6 feet back through right side railing along Keystone Avenue to the beginning of the yard of the 1st house 900 sq feet \$936.00.
 - 1 x VMS Treatment to baseball field at sports complex to fence lines and dugouts of the ballfield 450 sq feet \$425.00.
 - 1 x for knotweed patches at the corner of 1st & 3rd Mill Street treat patches of knotweed from road down to the edge of the back side of the land holder's property. Approx. 200 sq ft \$780.00
 - 1 x VMS to sports complex to treat all fence lines around the football and track areas, inside edge of the track, two long jump pits, handicap parking area, under bleachers and press box, trt gravel along the top of retaining wall behind concession stand end to end & two drainage ditches, one from the end of the retention wall to the end of the parking and one below the parking to the road coming up the hill 450 sq feet \$1,482.00.

Howe Township has received the revised EMS Agreement and met on February 10th for approval. We now need to sign it and send a copy to the Howe Township for a completed agreement.

Cameron Energy is drilling in our township in the Cherry Run area. Brooks Whilton is drilling in Mead Township.
