**CDBG Budget Modification for FY 2019:** Lorri Dunlap stated that this is not unusual; as projects finish sometimes, they come in under budget. We need to spend the oldest money first, so we have to move money around.

Therefore, we need to do a modification of Warren County's FFY 2019 CDBG program budget is approved as follows:

Bear Lake Center Street Reconstruction project budget will be reduced by (\$63,100) and those funds will be moved into the budget for the Clarendon Borough Center Street Storm Water Project budget; and

1 East Main St Demolition project budget in Youngsville Borough will be reduced by (\$27,803.76) and added to the RDA's Demolition of Blighted Properties Program; and

From the County's General Fund, \$5,430.00 will be moved into the Bear Lake Center Street Reconstruction Project to repay the County's CDBG program funds that were mis-allocated to the County's RDA program in 2013.

Commissioner Benjamin Kafferlin stated that these are all good projects for our support. He then asked if anyone had any questions to which there were none.

With nothing further, this public hearing was closed at 12:10.
