Farmington Twp. to join county zoning: Michael Lyon, Director of Planning & Zoning explained that Farmington Township from the mid 60's until 2012.

In 2023 the supervisors asked what is the process of getting back into county zoning. The planning office met with the supervisors several times.

On January 2, 2024, at their township meeting, they officially took a vote to go back to being zoned under the county. We then received their request letter on January 12, 2024.

The maps have been on display in the Township office, and the planning and zoning office for more than 45 days, and all advertising has been met.

It then went to the Planning Commission to be heard, and they recommended it go before the Commissioners for final approval.


Michael Lyon, Director of Planning & Zoning stated that by coming under county zoning our office with help with Flood Plain Management along with proper sewer management.
