I am aware of the following reasons for the discrepancies in our home - away survey:

Varsity football	Sheffield pays custodial overtime because they play Saturday games. Eisenhower pays higher security and portable toilet rentals than other schools.
Junior high football	Sheffield pays \$39 per referee where other schools pay \$34 because Sheffield ninth graders play JH football and thus they play a longer contest.
Cross-country	Youngsville transports their student-athletes to the Warren County Fair Grounds for their home meets.
Track and Field	Sheffield transports their student-athletes to War memorial Field for their home meets.
Warren High does not	pay game managers for most events, thus decreasing their expenses in several categories.
Warren High collects	entry fees at all War Memorial Field events, thus increasing their expenses at that venue.
