Academic Year 2024 Supporting Consultative Services

The AAC Institute Clinic has designed a supportive consultative service on augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) assistive technology for student(s) in the Warren County School District. The supportive consultative service will include declarative and procedural learning with guided opportunities to acquire new AAC skills on evidence-based practices. These supportive services include reviewing treatment protocol, assisting in creating evidence-based practice AAC activities and Environmental Communication Teaching (ECT) activities, and data collection procedures to monitor the students' gains.

Personnel: ICANTM Talk Clinic will provide speech-language pathologists licensed by the Commonwealth of PA and certified by the American Speech Language Hearing Association (ASHA). Our speech language pathologists serving the district have specialized training and years of clinical experience in augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) interventions and the evaluation and treatment of speech generating devices (SGDs). In addition, our speech language pathologists serving the district seek continual professional development in the areas of AAC, assistive technology, and special education. Our speech language pathologists may be accompanied by a graduate student in training from the University of Pittsburgh with appropriate clearances.

Liability: ICANTM Talk Clinic will carry general professional liability insurance (policy #AHY-518752013; Liberty Insurance Underwriters Inc.) covering all ICANTM Talk Clinic personnel throughout the term of this contract. ICANTM Talk Clinic will carry a Workman's Compensation Policy (policy # UB-9K51242A; Travelers).

In-Service AAC Trainings, Follow Up and Wrap-Up Session: Introduction/Observation of new students/staff to clinicians at the start of the year. This will be a maximum of 1 day for observing, addressing needs and any technical issues. The end of year wrap-up will be with the clinicians and 1 day of observing, addressing needs and any technical issues.

The AAC teams will be responsible for presenting goals/objectives, activities and progress on their selected student and providing support to other teams going through the training process. AAC Institute Clinic clinician will conduct observations and review data collection/analysis, provide on-site support for staff, Q&As, etc.

- Professional fee for introductory training in January:
1 clinician for 6 hours training the following week \$4000.00
- Professional fee for final May: including 1 clinician, up to
1 day observation and review of year \$4000.00
- Video review @ \$500/student for ____ **student(s) for 2 school
quarters with observations produced: March and April** \$500.00

******Travel expenses will include car rental, gasoline, meals, and miscellaneous out-of-pocket expenses for clinician. The minimum will be \$200.00/trip. These will be billed as they occur and are in addition to any other services.**

Payment will be due upon completion of each service within thirty days. A 10% late fee will be charged for every 30 days that payment has not been received. Receipts will be provided for expenses upon request. Cancellation of the agreed to dates must be rescheduled at the time of cancellation. If rescheduling does not occur, payment in full will be expected.
