Students who would like an additional items, may select something from the share table to go with their meal. The rule is "Take what you want, BUT eat what you take." Acceptable items to share are juice, milk, unopened prepackaged fruits and vegetables, unopened prepackages breakfast items, oranges, bananas, and unopened cereal.

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
