CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT, ADOPTION AND **REVIEW**

9151 - Graduation Outcomes 2000-2001 and Beyond

It is the policy of the Board of School Directors that students graduating from the Warren County School District and awarded a diploma must meet all of the graduation requirements of the District and the state. It is understood that from time to time these requirements will be changed by the authority of the Board or the state.

The District requirements for graduation and the awarding of a diploma are the following:

- 1. Achievement of proficiency **or advanced** in grades 11 and/or 12 on the state required Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) or the District's local assessment in mathematics, writing and reading and other areas required by the state.
- 2. Successful completion of the Graduation Project.
- 3. Successful completion of the District's required credits for grades 9, 10, 11, and 12.
- 4. Fulfillment of other graduation requirements mandated by the state and/or the District.
