Forensics Lab Tour Grant

<u>Grant Overview</u>: Current procedural television shows are promoting forensics as a possible profession for students. Forensic science relies on the knowledge of chemistry, and is an excellent occupation to showcase careers in the chemistry field. A Youngsville High School chemistry teacher intends to apply for School to Work funding to take YHS chemistry students to the forensic science lab at Mercyhurst College, where they will receive a tour of the facility and have the opportunity to interview both faculty and students on the education necessary to embark on a career in forensic science.

The grant funding would cover the transportation costs, lunch for the students while on the Mercyhurst campus, and substitute teacher time.

Alternatives if not Awarded: The proposed visit will not occur without the grant funding.
