

Lookin' Out Grant Summary

Grant Overview: Lookin' Out is a safe teen driving awareness program initiated by Erie Insurance to reduce auto crashes and promote safe driving habits among teens. Lookin' Out consists of a committee of students that create unique activities to remind their friends about the importance of driving responsibly. Each activity gets the students' attention and sends an effective safe driving message. Areas covered include:

- Seat belt use
- Speeding or reckless behavior
- Limiting the number of passengers in the car
- Alcohol and drug use, and their effects on driving
- Eliminating distractions such as cell phones and loud music
