Each unit will be approximately six weeks long and focus on unexplained events of history.

The overall course Big Idea is "How can we determine events from the past?"

- Ancient History Mysteries: 6 weeks long. Topics include:
 - Who Invented the Alphabet?
 - Was King Tut Murdered?
 - Troy: Was there a horse?
 - Stonehenge
 - Is Atlantis a Legend?
 - The Terracotta Soldiers
 - Did King Arthur Exist?
 - Mysterious Lines
 - Statues on Easter Island
 - The Secret of the Iceman's Death
- World History Mysteries: 6 weeks long. Topics include:
 - The Knights Templars and their Treasure
 - Did Marco Polo Really travel to China?
 - The Fingerprints of Shakespeare
 - Who was the Man in the iron mask?
 - Could Mozart have been murdered?
 - Beethoven's Love letters
 - The Mystery of the Mary Celeste
 - The Sinking of the Lusitania
 - The Missing Bones of Peking Man
- American History Mysteries: 6 weeks long. Topics include:
 - Who Really discovered the Americas?
 - What Happened to the Lost Colony?
 - The Salem Witch Trials
 - The Lincoln Assassination Conspiracy
 - The Explosion on the Maine
 - The Lindburgh Baby kidnapping
 - Amelia Earhart's Disappearance
 - Were the Rosenbergs Wrongly Convicted?
 - The JFK Assassination
