What to Expect

The IU5 ELECT Program provides student focused programming to support expectant, pregnant and parenting students to stay in school, have a healthy family and pregnancy, and to graduate from high school with a plan.

Case managers work with students to develop goals that lead to success in their dual role as student and parent.

Support for these students to overcome barriers to graduation is provided through group classes, individual case management, home visits, as well as connections and referrals to local resources.

Students in the program earn incentive points which can be redeemed for items of their choice.

Who is Eligible?

Pregnant and Parenting students under the age of 22 who are enrolled in a school or GED program.
