

Food Service Department Update - February 2009

Menus:

Regional Menus have been established throughout the WCSD. We now have 15 different Menus for the District, plus additional menus for Head Start and Jefferson. We also offer these choices for LEC student pickup.

Specialty Menus for Students – Students with Medical Issues who have submitted Physicians notes receive special menus. Throughout the school year we have provided Gluten Free Menus to six students in five different school locations, one Gluten Free/Acid Reflux menu, one High Fiber Menu, one Class three special diet menu, one Reduced Calorie Menu, and one Restricted Protein Menu. We also provide water and lactaid for many WCSD students with Lactose intolerance.

Nutritionals are updated as new products are added and changed on our menus. These are posted on WCSD Website and sent to all WCSD nursing staff who daily administer medications based on food intake.
