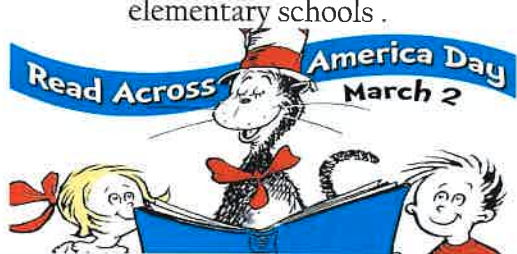
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It's always fun in the cafeteria especially when The Cat In The Hat comes rolling in for a visit during breakfast and lunch to all our elementary schools.
