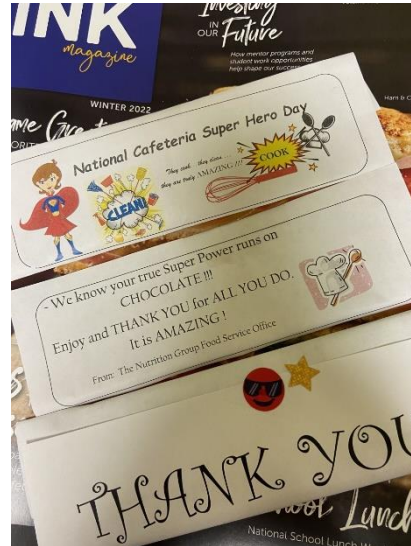


# School Lunch Hero Day

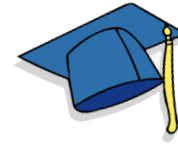

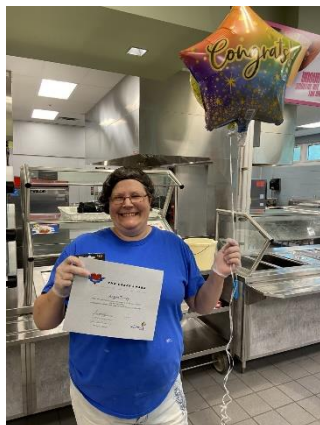

A few updates from our Corporate Purchasing Team and the supply chain

Though the 2021-2022 school year is drawing to a close, we're already laying the foundation for the 2022-2023 school year. Here's a few updates:

- We're collaborating with our chefs and dietitians to continue selecting new menu items for next school year.
- Bids from food, paper and cleaning suppliers were competitive; prevalent challenges for the upcoming school year include lead times and pricing guarantees
- We awarded vendor contracts mid-May and will be placing our initial forecast with each manufacturer.
- Throughout May we met with our distributor to place opening orders, schedule product for arrival at appointed depots and project timely delivery for school start-up for the 2022-2023 school year.

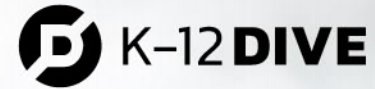

## USDA: States can still apply for limited school nutrition waivers

**May 2, 2022** – The USDA update, shared in their webinar, shows the agency is still working to help schools within its legal abilities, school nutrition advocates said. National pandemic-era waivers are set to expire June 30 unless Congress reauthorizes USDA's authority to extend these emergency provisions.

Fiala said the USDA has been speaking the past several months with state agencies and school meal program operators to understand their concerns and get feedback.

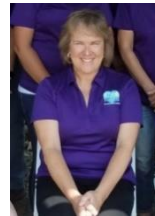
