Please consider reducing the gate fee charged at War Memorial Field for Track and

Field meets from: Adults \$4.00 to: Adults \$2.00 Students \$2.00 to: Students \$1.00

- Unlike fall activities, there are no lighting expenses associated with these events.
- There is little or no custodial expense and only minimal water use related to Track and Field activities.
- Attendance at Track and Field events is rather low so there would not be a great impact on revenue. With a lower gate fee, some spectators who currently watch from the street may pay admission.
- Many times, parents come to an event to watch their sons or daughters compete in the events in which they participate and leave when they are finished. \$4.00 seems like a high price for such a brief attendance.
- All proceeds are submitted to The Warren Sports Boosters. The Warren Sports Boosters president, Mr. Don Moore, has endorsed this request.
