5. Requests to the PIAA Board of Directors for approval of Cooperative Sponsorship of a Sport agreements must be submitted <u>on or before October 1 of any odd-numbered year</u> to the applicable PIAA District Committee for its recommendation to the PIAA Board of Directors for that proposed agreement to be <u>considered for adoption for the immediately following two-year reclassification cycle.</u> Requests for approval must include the resolution of the School Board.

8. Cooperative Sponsorship of a Sport agreements will be enforced for a minimum of two years. Approved Cooperative Sponsorship of a Sport agreements need be resubmitted to the PIAA District Committee and the PIAA Board of Directors only to request modification or termination of the agreements. Such requests for modification or termination must be submitted to the PIAA District Committee for consideration by October 1 of any odd-numbered year. The PIAA District Committee shall submit the request for modification or termination to the PIAA Board of Directors by the December meeting of any odd-numbered year to be considered for the immediately following two-year reclassification cycle. Requests to modify or terminate the agreement must be initiated by all of the schools. However, if the agreement has been in place for at least four years, any school to the agreement may submit a request to modify or terminate the agreement.

Any student whose own school does not sponsor a particular sport and who was a member of a Team while a Cooperative Sponsorship of a Sport Agreement was in place may, upon termination of such agreement, and with the consent of the Principals of the schools to the agreement, continue to participate on such Team as if said agreement remains in effect.
