

WAEC has nine tutors working throughout the school day at all four grade levels. These tutors work specifically on language arts to improve reading skills. After the classroom teachers have delivered the initial reading instruction, the tutors sometimes work side by side with the classroom teachers during language arts, providing support and reinforcement on specific skills in a small group setting. At other times, they work with small groups during recess and academic support. At the primary level, they often work at a learning center within the classroom during reading time. In all cases, their presence and support allow both our classroom teachers and tutors to work with smaller groups of children to help develop stronger independent reading skills.

Our tutors are using the adopted Harcourt Brace language arts materials. The children's needs and learning levels dictate what is used for intervention, including leveled readers, strategic intervention kits, and intervention station kits.
