Three of our six schools that will consolidate at the end of this school year have school bells on the front lawns: North Warren, Pleasant, and Jefferson Elementary. I have researched the possibility of having them restored and mounted either in a free standing tower or in their existing frames with both the Elderhorst Bell Co., Allentown, PA and Brosamer Bells, Michigan. The lowest estimate was \$7345.00 for restoration and a minimum of \$10,000 for a tower. This does not include shipping. I have sought, without success, community funds to proceed with this project. At this time I feel that cost prohibits this restoration of the bells.

On March 31, 2000, North Warren Presbyterian Church requested that the North Warren school bell be preserved in the community. I have attached their letter.

The bells have been preserved by the community schools, and I feel that it would be appropriate to move them to the new elementary center. At this time, I recommend that consideration be given to the North Warren request and that the remaining bells be mounted in the courtyard of the Warren Area Elementary Center.
