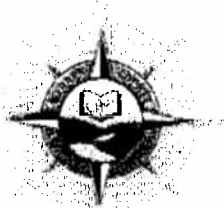

We solicited four bids with Kingsview Paving of Lakewood, NY coming in the lowest at \$8,500.

This basketball court will be used by all grade levels at YEMS.


Kingsview has asked to meet with a representative of YEMS PTO to go over the project specs and site prior to the project. The PTO prefers this meeting take place with Mr. Mineweaser as he can offer direction as to where the district prefers this court to be located. He is also authorized by PTO to make any changes in specs necessary as recommended by Kingsview to ensure a quality project.

The schedule for this project has not been set, pending approval by the WCSD BOD. The actual work can be completed in one day once Kingsview arrives on scene.

The YEMS PTO has the cash on hand from fundraisers to pay for the project; no further fundraising is necessary.
