

## Students

- All 9-12 Sheffield Area Middle High School (SAMHS) students will take three core classes (ELA, math and science) at Warren Area High School (WAHS)  
**OR**
- Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade SAMHS students will take three core classes (ELA, math and science) at WAHS  
**OR**
- Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade SAMHS students will take three core classes (ELA, math and science) at WAHS  
**OR**
- Incoming 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade SAMHS students will take three core classes (ELA, math and science) at WAHS
- SAMHS students will be permitted to stay at WAHS, if desired
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade SAMHS students seeking acceleration by taking high school classes can take courses at WAHS or virtually

## Sports

- No change to sports offerings @ SAMHS
- Students taking half their courses at SAMHS are eligible to play sports at SAMHS
- Sports enrollment minimum number procedures remain in place
- Abraxis cooperative agreement remains in place
- Mascot and school colors will not change at SAMHS

## Student Status

- Students taking half their courses at SAMHS remain Sheffield students
- Students taking half their courses at SAMHS graduate as Sheffield students
- Students taking half their courses at SAMHS are eligible for academic recognition at SAMHS

## Transportation

- Three of the current fleet of nine buses will transport 9-12 students from SAMHS to WAHS and back to SAMHS
- One additional van will be needed to transport 9-12 students from Cherry Grove
- Transportation changes will cost an additional \$24,900
- SAMHS students could have their day extended by the amount of time used to travel to and from WAHS  
**OR**
- SAMHS students use Advisory time to travel

- Additional runs from WAHS to SAMHS can be added

## **Class Size**

- Current class size procedures will be used at both WAHS and SAMHS

## **Teachers**

- The majority of WAHS teacher preps will stay the same. SAMHS teachers moving to WAHS will have a decrease.
- There are currently itinerant specials teachers that travel from building to building, and this model would include itinerant schedules for electives.
- If there is a decision to extend the school day, the teacher contract provides the flexibility to set the times for the workday.
