TEACHERS' AND EMPLOYEES' AUTHORITY

Teachers organize their classes within guidelines agreed to by the administration. You are expected to follow teachers' instructions to complete their course requirements. Disputes will be settled by the administration if students have questions regarding a teacher's regulations.

In the classroom, teachers will establish certain rules which they deem necessary in developing an atmosphere conducive to learning. It is the responsibility of each student to respect these rules as well as the general policies of the school.

You are also expected to comply with all instructions and directives given by any employee of the District while on District property, at any school or school-related activity, or while in transit to and from school or a school-related activity. Conduct that constitutes insubordination or which interferes with maintaining a favorable school atmosphere will not be tolerated. Students are encouraged to exhibit good behavior and to practice the principles of good citizenship at all times while on District property, at any school or school-related activity, or while in transit to and from school or a school-related activity.
