- Miller Hill and East of Miller Hill runs to Warren would likely add, on average, 10 to 15 minutes to each route when rerouted.
- West of Miller Hill runs to Youngsville would likely add, on average, 10-15 minutes to each route when re-routed.
- The earliest pick up times in the Northern attendance area today are around 6:45 a.m.
- The latest drop off times in the Northern attendance area today are around 4:10 p.m.
- Re-routing would in most cases alter pick up and drop off times for students.




