## 2400 Public Participation Comment at Board Meetings

## 2410 <u>Guidelines</u>

The presiding officer shall be guided by the following rules:

- 1. Public participation **comment** shall occur: as scheduled on the agenda and at the discretion of the presiding officer on a given issue.
  - a. as scheduled on the agenda,
  - b. prior to the Board's discussion on a new motion that is not on the agenda, and
  - c. at the discretion of the presiding officer on a given issue.
- 2. Whenever issues identified by the participant are subject to remediation under policies and procedures of the Board, they shall be dealt with in accordance with these policies and procedures. The Board requires requests that public participants be residents of this district or anyone representing represent a group in the community or school district.
- 3. In circumstances where time will permit, the **The** presiding officer will allow for **at least** two (2) periods of public participation **comment**.

The first period shall be a maximum of thirty (30) minutes in length; individual speakers addressing the Board during this first period shall be limited to five (5) three (3) minutes duration each. Priority will be given to comments concerning an agenda item. Those wishing to address the Board during the first period will sign a roster before the meeting convenes. The five (5) minute duration may be reduced at the discretion of the presiding officer depending upon the number of persons enrolled on the roster. The roster will include the following:

- a. name.
- b. address,
