9405 Adult Education

The Board recognizes that education is a lifelong process. Therefore, programs may be offered which meet the educational, vocational career, and recreational needs of adult learners.

While sponsored by the Board, it is the intent that the adult program shall be self-supporting through tuition fees, grants, and PDE reimbursement.

Adult education programs shall be administered under the direction of the Superintendent and may include (but will not necessarily be limited to) the following components:

- Adult Basic Education
- GED Preparation and Testing
- Vocational/Career Programs
- Recreational Courses
- Academic/Career Programs

Procedures shall be developed under the direction of the Superintendent or his/her designee.

Non-District Adult Programs

The Board may enter into agreements with public agencies, Local Education Agencies (LEA's) and private educational organizations to house adult education programs at Warren County School District facilities.

Adult Students in WCSD Programs

Principals may approve the enrollment of adults aged 21 and older in Warren County School District and Warren County Career Center secondary courses when class size allows such enrollment. Adult students must have state child abuse clearances on file before enrolling. The District will not assume the cost of clearances. The principal can deny a request for enrollment without cause. Adult students will be withdrawn from a course or courses without cause at the discretion of the principal.

The Superintendent will annually establish adult course fees and material fees.
