

Project 720 Grant

- I. Action Plan completed since February 27, 2006
 - A. Mr. Bill Nichols presented an overview of Project 720 to the IMT on Wednesday, March 15, 2006. Topics covered were project goals, obligation of the grantee throughout the grant, and reporting requirements.
 - B. Dr. John Sechriest met with Mr. Richard Lansberry, Project 720 Director/Curriculum Coordinator from Harbor Creek School District to discuss the district's involvement with Project 720.
 - C. Dr. John Sechriest met with Debra Sturm, Supervisor of Curriculum at Millcreek School District to discuss their district's involvement in Project 720.
 - D. Mr. Matt Jones has been in contact with Dr. Parker Martin, Division of Middle and Secondary Education Chief at PDE regarding the grant application procedures.
- II. Feedback from the interactions listed in Item I.
 - A. The districts' projects focus on the defined needs/goals of each individual district. This is different from the usual grant which focuses on the guidelines/needs of the grantor.
 - B. Individual district's goal setting guides project development. Study, networking, and planning are necessary components before the implementation phase can be initiated.
 - C. Technical support is as near as the nearest phone/computer.
 - D. Each participating district is required to attend two (2) mandatory meetings per year and complete an annual report on meeting the district's project goals. The Project 720 staff will visit each district once a year, more if requested by the district.
 - E. This is a three (3) year grant, renewal annually.
