The Warren County School District Gifted Support Program will...

- 1. be implemented in school year 2006-2007
- 2. adhere to the Pennsylvania Department of Education Chapter 16 Guidelines
- 3. have a .5 FTE principal
- 4. have a .5 dedicated K-12 counselor
- 5. provide gifted support programming for grades K-8 students at the Learning and Enrichment Center
- 6. provide gifted support programming for grades 9-12 students at home schools
- 7. emphasize both enrichment and acceleration in grades K-12 with a focus on enrichment in grades K-8 and a focus on acceleration in grades 9-12
- 8. have professional development for all District teachers of the gifted regarding GIEPs and provide District-wide training for classroom teacher support of gifted students
- 9 develop strategies to increase participation in program activities by grades 9-12 students
- 10. determine the assessment tools to be used with PSSA scores to evaluate the program
- 11. involve parents in the end-of-the-year program evaluation
- 12. establish an advisory group to meet each semester with the gifted support program teachers and administrators.
