Warren Athletics Swimming Proposal

Proposal: Warren Area High School would like to drop their cooperative agreement with Eisenhower, Sheffield, and Youngsville High Schools in the sports of Boys' and Girls' Swimming and Diving

Dropping our cooperative agreement(s):

- would allow the student athletes at Warren Area High School the chance to compete against schools at the AA level instead of the AAA level
- would enable the student-athletes at WAHS to compete against schools our size like Oil City, Titusville, Franklin, and General McLane like we do in all other sports
- would not handicap students at Eisenhower, Sheffield, and Youngsville High Schools since currently no students from those schools participate on the WAHS swim team
- would enable more WAHS student-athletes to compete in the state swim meet since the times at AA are slower than those at AAA
- would not prohibit a student from any of the county schools from competing or practicing with the WAHS swim team. Rather students from all of the county schools would be welcome to participate as "independents" and represent their own school
- will cut down on some of our travel costs as trips to Oil City, Titusville, and Franklin are shorter than going to Erie
