Some thoughts concerning the wide variety and large number of non-athletic supplemental contracts supported by the principals of our schools include:

- There is a distinction between co-curricular and instructional positions.
- The WCSD Athletic/Co-Curricular Employees' Handbook states that "...Volunteer staff is not to be left alone with students/athletes." However, this is not a WCSD Board Policy statement.
- Of the co-curricular positions the following are related to safety:

bus ramp

crossing guard

• Of the instructional positions the following are necessary parts of the curriculum in each school:

band director

choir

department head/team leader

detention

Math/School improvement

Nova Net coordinator

newspapers

student council/government

tutoring supervisor

yearbook advisor, sales, typist and business board

• The following positions provide compensation for significant after school curricular responsibilities including concerts and PMEA activities.

Band Director

• The following positions prepare facilities and distribute hardware.

Audio Visual

Auditorium Stage Crew

- The class advisor positions have varying responsibilities depending upon the grade level and school. In some cases, there may well be more responsibilities that one person can assume.
- The following are "county wide" positions.

• The following positions could have number quotas assigned to them. They could perhaps be included In Board Policy 10465.
