  - integration of other disciplines
  - alignment with state and local standards
  - special education/inclusion component
  - remediation component
  - gifted education component
- C. Curriculum areas will be reviewed and/or rewritten every 6 years beginning as designated in the Curriculum Cycle.
- D. Review of curriculum implies review of instructional materials but does not necessarily imply the adoption of new materials.
- E. Curriculum review and monitoring will be done on a yearly basis.
