The Northwest Tri-County Intermediate Unit will:

- Provide online curriculum services
- Provide curriculum support for Liaisons.
- Provide quarterly tracking assistance.
- Provide marketing assistance.
- Provide equipment for required services: computer, keyboard, monitor, modem, printer, mouse, software, Internet service, and student portfolio (if applicable).
- Provide technical support for hardware (if applicable).
- Provide an orientation to e-learning.
- Invoice for services provided.

The School District will:

- Provide students with a free and appropriate public education until the *Cyber Services* begin.
- Require the IEP team to reconvene with LFA present to review and revise IEP to reflect recommendations for services if IEP is required for child.

- Include *Cyber Services* students in mandatory State tests within their district
- Provide academic support.
- Market *Cyber Services* to identified audiences.
- Pay registration fees as invoiced by the IU.
- Identify a liaison between the district/program and the IU and monitor students' time on-line.
- Complete all paperwork with appropriate signatures.
- Make decisions on the continued enrollment of students that abuse services, exhibit non-compliance with the attendance requirements of *Cyber Services* or are continually performing below basic on assessments.
- Contact the IU of any change in student status.
- Assist in the return of IU equipment from the student (if applicable).
- Ensure that the students possess basic computer skills.

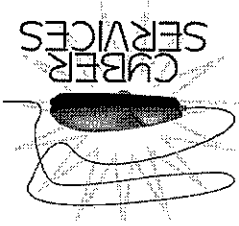
