Mrs. Nancy Siggins, Treasurer:

I have developed an interest in two parcels of land in Warren County. These two parcels are located on Jackson Street Extension, just inside of the city boundary. They are identified by Warren County Tax Map WN-585 as parcels WN-585-7742 and WN-585-7751. Each parcel is 50' x 150'. They are on a very steep incline accessable only by foot. They were previously owned by Dennie Dipierrio. They went up for tax sale, with no bidders. They were again offered for sale by the court, with no bidders. At this time they were placed in repository by the court.

I would like to offer the county two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per parcel. Four hundred dollars (\$400.00) total, to have these two parcels deeded to me. This would put these properties back on the tax roll.

I have enclosed a copy of the maps, illustrating their location and a copy of the old assesment sheets to familiarize you with the parcels. I would like to thank you ahead of time for your time in researching and considering this offer.
