

10400 STUDENT ACTIVITIES**10410 Students Enrolled in Private/Parochial Schools, **Cyber Schools, Charter Schools, and Home School Programs** Participation in Co-Curricular Activities**

Students enrolled in private/parochial schools, **cyber schools, charter schools, or home school programs** shall be eligible to participate in co-curricular activities at the District school within the District attendance area **within which the student resides** ~~of the parochial/private-school~~ **provided that the activity is not offered at the school attended by the student. Students who wish to participate in such activities must meet the same eligibility and try-out criteria and must comply with all applicable policies, rules, and regulations governing the activity. The District shall not be responsible for transporting students to and from the locations of the co-curricular activities.**

In order for a student to participate in accordance with the preceding paragraph, ~~For parochial or private school students to be eligible for participation,~~ the Administrator in charge of ~~that~~ **the student's school (or where appropriate the student's parent or the student)** must ~~complete~~ **submit** the proper application ~~procedures and submit those forms~~ to the Superintendent's Office. Once completed, the Superintendent or his/her designee will forward the application to the Board for its consideration with his/her recommendation pertaining to the application.

~~—The student shall be required to follow the rules and school policies of the District and P.I.A.A. rules and regulations when applicable. The private and/or parochial school entity is responsible for transporting the student to and from the District.~~
