3.1 Maintenance Project Estimates

Discussion:

The maintenance project estimates list continues to be updated with input from building administrators and maintenance staff. Summer projects are selected from this list.

Sugar Grove Elementary School is in need of improvements to the windows and the window wall system. Currently it costs approximately three times as much to heat SGES (\$0.96 / sq. ft.) as it does to heat Warren Area Elementary Center (\$0.33).

Throughout the district, many multi-purpose and / or gymnasium spaces are lit with older style metal halide and mercury vapor lights. Several of these lights require a warm up and cool down period. Energy efficient fluorescent lighting can eliminate the wait times thereby providing a safer environment. New lighting will save an estimated \$11,673.00 per year in energy costs over current fixtures.

That the Board of School Directors approves a work order in an amount not to exceed the DGS fee schedule for drawings and specifications necessary to replace windows at Sugar Grove Elementary School.

Motion 2:

That the Board of School Directors approves a work order in an amount not to exceed the DGS fee schedule for drawings and specifications necessary to replace and upgrade lighting fixtures at Beaty Warren Middle School gymnasium and auxiliary gymnasium; Eisenhower Middle High School gymnasium; Sheffield Area Middle High School gymnasium and auxiliary gymnasium; Sheffield Elementary School multipurpose room; Sugar Grove Elementary School multipurpose room; South Street Early Learning Center multipurpose room; Youngsville High School gymnasium and auxiliary gymnasium; and Warren Area High School gymnasium, 2 (two) auxiliary gymnasiums, wrestling room, and cafeteria.
