Please consider a proposal to re-establish season passes for parents of our student-athletes. In the past we have offered "Parent Passes" at our schools and charged ½ the rate of the total cost of admission to all home events for a particular sport. This proposal is to offer the passes at a "buy one get one free" concept. That would be; buy one pass at full price and get a second pass free. The pass would be accepted only at the home school of the parent's child. A typical fee would be \$24.00 for two basketball passes where the team played 8 home games.

The net financial impact would likely be a decrease in revenue because of the reduced admission fee for the total season. There would be an expense to the endeavor as the passes would have to be created.

Proposal: That the Board of School directors permits the sale of sport

specific season passes to adult family members of WCSD student-athletes and marching band student-muscians. Further that the rate for those passes be buy one pass at the regular total admission fee for all home games in that season and get one free. This practice would exclude events hosted at War Memorial

Field and events sponsored by private organizations.
