

The Warren County School District Alternative Education for Disruptive Youth Program (AEP) provides an educational program for regular and special education at risk students enrolled in Warren County School District. The school offers enrollment for 20 at risk students in grades seven – twelve.

WCSD AEP offers behavioral and academic support via self-contained classrooms where students have the opportunity to pursue the WCSD curriculum and participate in counseling. One of the major strengths of the WCSD AEP is the expertise and dedication of the staff.

Admission to the WCSD AEP would consist of an internal process or written request for voluntary entry.

The internal process includes the following steps:

1. Student acquires ≥ 15 discipline referrals
2. Behavior plan established at home school
3. Administration recommendation
4. Approval from Board of School Directors, Director of Secondary Education, Director of Special Education and/or Superintendent
5. AEP enrollment meeting with AEP administrator

Once a student is enrolled he/she will be required to meet three established goals prior to exiting the WCSD AEP. Goals will be established for attendance, behavior and academics. Every 45-days the WCSD AEP administrator will meet with the student to review progress toward established goals and send progress reports to parents. Students not making progress may be formally expelled from WCSD at which time they would be required to attend the Beacon Light Alternative Education Program.

Quick Facts

Established Goals

1. Academic Goal - during the enrollment meeting the parent, student and administrator will establish an academic goal.
2. Behavior Goal - Upon entry into AEP observations of the student's behavior will be conducted to establish a Positive Behavior Intervention Plan and a long-term behavior goal. Behavior will be tracked on a daily basis (period by period) via the established behavior point system. Daily behavior will be graphed every 45-days to illustrate student progress/regression.
3. Attendance Goal – Students entering the WCSD AEP must maintain a clean attendance record showing reduction in the number of absences from the home school.
