2010 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Alcohol Education Grant

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) is offering grants of up to \$15,000 to act as seed monies to initiate programs that focus on strategies to reduce underage and dangerous drinking. The WCSD administration has met with several local law enforcement agencies, and they are interested in helping with such an effort. The administration is currently working with local non-profits experienced in the area of underage drinking/alcohol education to determine if there are programs available that could be implemented through the PLCB funding.

Amount of Award: \$15,000.00

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: Due February 25, 2010. Notification should be within 1-2 months of submission.

Alternatives if not Awarded: The project will not take place without the grant funding.

<u>WCSD Resources Required</u>: There is a 25% cash match requirement. No in-kind match is allowable. If a suitable source of matching funds cannot be found, the proposal will not be submitted.

Administrative Recommendation: The Board of Directors instructs the administration to apply to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Alcohol Education Program for up to \$15,000 to deliver alcohol education programming to Warren County School District students.
