Safe and Drug Free School and Communities Mini-Grant

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The district currently is using carry-over funds from its 2009-10 Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities grant to provide Student Assistance Program services and training, as well as bullying prevention programming. Although the grant was zeroed for 2010-11 and beyond, the state recently informed the district that it has a small amount of 2009-10 funds remaining and intends to award them using a mini-grant process.

The district proposes applying for \$2,000 in mini-grant funding to pay for SAP training for district staff. The training is scheduled for early May 2011.

Amount of Award: \$2,000

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: End of March 2001. Notification in April 2011.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: Training will be paid through an existing budget line if no award is received.

WCSD Resources Required: None.

Administrative Recommendation: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to submit an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Education Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Mini-Grant to provide Student Assistance Program (SAP) training for district staff.
