Tax Incentive Rebate Program

<u>Grant Overview</u>: For the past several years, the Warren County Career Center has worked with local businesses - like Ellwood National Forge – to participate in the state tax incentive rebate program. The program allows businesses to designate a portion of the taxes paid to the state to be used for local projects. The Warren County Career Center (WCCC) has received financial support through the program for the past three years.

In order to be considered for future funding, the WCCC must send a letter to businesses requesting support. If the request is approved, the WCCC will be contacted at a later date by the Pennsylvania Department of Education informing them of the businesses that elected to participate, as well as the amount of the award.

There is no guarantee of funding.

Amount of Award: Unknown at this time.

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: The administration anticipates notification in October/November 2011.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: Some machining program resources will be eliminated at the Warren County Career Center.

WCSD Resources Required: None.

<u>Administrative Recommendation</u>: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration of the Warren County Career Center to solicit support from local businesses through participation in the Tax Incentive Rebate Program.
