11010 Relations with Parent Organizations/Booster Organizations

Parent-teacher associations may be established for each school building in the District and District-wide. The building principals of each school will serve as the liaison officer representing the District. Membership and rules governing school building organizations will be determined by each school and placed in writing. Activities of school organizations, insofar as they are related to school purposes, will be evaluated by the principal of the particular school.

The Board recognizes that the endeavors and objectives of booster organizations and similar groups can be a valuable means of stimulating interest in and endorsement of the aims and achievements of our District.

Prior to July 1 of each year, all parent organizations and booster organizations shall provide to the Superintendent, in writing, a list of the current officers of the organization. Said organizations shall also immediately advise the Superintendent, in writing, of any change in the officers that occurs during the year. Any gifts/donations made by a parent organization or booster organization to the District shall be governed by Policy 11501.
