Approximately seven years ago, Laura Tingley received a state or federal grant to construct a memorial park and garden on the Youngsville High School property, between Woodard Street and the Brokenstraw Creek. A pavilion was erected on a cement slab. Paving was added for parking and a garden 72 feet x 8 feet was planted.

Laura left Youngsville, and I do not know who was responsible for the upkeep of this garden. A couple Youngsville High School Seniors worked on it as a senior project. I became involved with it because of my grandsons senior project, to help him with plant identification. After he graduated, my husband, daughter, and I would periodically clean it up. The Japanese Knotweed is impossible to remove.

Several concerned citizens of Youngsville would volunteer their time to try to make it look better. Now the timbers bordering the garden are rotten and unstable with large timber nails sticking out, presenting a safety hazard.

Jean Zock and I would like to have the timbers removed, shorten the garden to a manageable size, have highway fabric added, with large gravel rock on top. Place large landscape rocks on top of this so driving and parking cannot be on this area. There are two memorial slabs, which were removed from the school when some renovation was completed. We would like to have them placed around the garden as a border. One reads, Dr. J. F. Whiten Memorial and the other 19 GYMN 26.

We have an estimate from Laugers Good Lawn for \$757.00. When Barry Tingley moved to Florida, he gave me the check book with the balance to be used for this garden. A sign was erected in the pavilion "Dedicated to the ones who suffered the tragedy of the Columbine High School shooting". Plants and mulch were also purchased. There is enough left in the account to complete this project. The account is Youngsville Middle Senior High Memorial Fund c/o Louise Dyer.

We would like an answer on this project as soon as possible, so the contractor can get started before his busy season starts. We have several plants that need to be remove before the work can be started.


