2012-13 Title II, Part A Plan

<u>Grant Overview</u>: Title II, Part A, is a 100% Federally-funded supplemental educational program that provides financial assistance to improve the skills of teachers and the quality of instruction in core academic subjects. The Warren County School District used its 2011-12 Title II allocation to train administrators and teacher leaders on the inclusionary model, as well as to support conferences relevant to teachers' areas of expertise to insure that they remain current in their content areas. Title II monies were also used to pay teachers for time spent on locally-important trainings on anchors, standards, data analysis, etc.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education has not yet released preliminary allocations for 2012-13 Title II, Part A.

In addition to the professional development activities, the district expects to provide two teacher-coaches and one-half of the cyber-school liaison position.
