# Warren County School District Russell Elementary School PDE Project #2905 Notes to PLANCON J – Project Accounting Based on Final Costs

## NOTE 1 - PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The accompanying financial schedules present the final costs and financing sources of the Russell Elementary School Renovation/Addition project ("the Project"). Bids were opened April 29, 2003. These schedules only include activity within three years of the bid opening date.

Methodology for Allocating Costs – Costs were allocated between New and Existing facilities based on original contractors' bids as adjusted by approved change orders.
