4 It is the policy of the Board of School Directors that students graduating from the Warren County  
5 School District and awarded a diploma must meet all of the graduation requirements of the  
6 District and the state. It is understood that from time to time these requirements will be changed  
7 by the authority of the Board or the state.

8 The District requirements for graduation and the awarding of a diploma are the following:

- 9 **1.** Achievement of proficiency or advanced in grades 11 and/or 12 on the state required  
10 Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) or the District's local assessment in  
11 mathematics, writing and reading and other areas required by the state. **Commencing**  
12 **with the class of students who are expected to graduate at the end of the 2013-2014**  
13 **academic year, students shall be required to achieve proficiency or advanced in no**  
14 **later than Grade 11 on the Keystone Exams in Algebra I, Literature, Biology, and**  
15 **other areas required by the state.**
- 16 2. Successful completion of the Graduation Project.
- 17 3. Successful completion of the District's required credits for grades 9, 10, 11, and 12.
- 18 4. Fulfillment of other graduation requirements mandated by the state and/or the District.
