Support for Spain/Italy Student Trip

<u>Grant Overview</u>: WCSD instructor Jewel Rozanski will be taking a group of students to Spain and Italy with several other adult chaperones. The trip will take place in June of 2013. At this time there are 16 students enrolled for the trip. The students are from EMHS, WAHS, and SAMHS.

The itinerary includes Madrid, Barcelona, Toledo, Rome, and Pompeii. Each location will include visits to important sites, and students will be required to keep journals in English or Spanish to document the experience and what they learn.

The cost per participant is approximately \$4,000, and at least four fundraisers have been held to date to help defray student costs. The request for support will not include a specific dollar amount, but rather be a request for assistance as the Foundation sees fit to provide. The Foundation has provided such support in the past.

Amount of Award: Open-ended.

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: Due immediately. Notification after the next foundation board meeting.

Alternatives if not Awarded: Students will need to raise additional funds for the trip.
