3.1 BWMS 2013-2014 Assignment of Sixth Grade

The staff in the building is working collaboratively and has a positive attitude. The construction project should be completed in its entirety by January 2014.

### 3.2 WCSD 2013-2014 Special Education Programs

**Discussion:** A plan was presented for special education programs that will utilize resources more effectively. It is being recommended that, over a three to five year period, a full-time autistic support program and a full-time emotional support program, which will be made available for students in all grade levels and be based in the east and west attendance areas. A Life Skills program, as directed by students' Individual Education Plans, will be available in the central attendance area. Students that need these special education services will be transported to the areas where they are offered. Learning Support will still be available as it is presently being delivered.

**Action:** Student numbers and costs will be brought to the committee at the March meeting.
