

American Honda Foundation Grant Summary

Grant Overview: The American Honda Foundation supports projects focused on youth education, specifically in the areas of science, technology, engineering, mathematics (STEM), the environment, job training and literacy. An instructor at Eisenhower Middle High School is interested in developing an application that would expand the technology activities in his classroom to incorporate more STEM-related activities. The STEM activities would be incorporated in the existing Engineering, Design, and Manufacturing curricula.

Administration is still exploring the grant with the instructor, as well as potential opportunities to expand it to all four district high schools. Administration will choose a submission timeline if a project can be developed that stands a good chance of receiving an award.

Amount of Award: \$20,000 - \$75,000

Due Date/Notification of Award: February 1, May 1, August 1, or November 1, 2013. Notification to follow review by funder.

Alternatives if not Awarded: None.

Administrative Recommendation: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to assist in the exploration and development of an application to the American Honda Foundation with the intent of providing additional STEM opportunities within existing technology education curricula.
