This would provide a clear number one for recognition. | <input type="checkbox"/> A shared ranking with all students recognized equally for achieving Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, and Cum Laude. This would not clearly indicate students by official rank. | <input type="checkbox"/> A ranking system in which all students that finish above a particular GPA such as 100 would share the number one ranking and would all be recognized as number one with the actual ranking only appearing on the official transcript. |
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**2 a Only students meeting the following criteria would be eligible for senior recognition:**

| <input type="checkbox"/> Students will be eligible for scholastic recognition if they have been enrolled as a full-time student in the District for their entire <u>junior and senior year</u> . A full-time student is defined as a student who earns a minimum of six (6) credits during both his/her junior and senior year. Students who were full-time students in the District their junior year and fulfilled their graduation requirements by earning fewer than six (6) credits their senior year will be eligible for scholastic recognition at the end of their senior year. | <input type="checkbox"/> Students will be eligible for scholastic recognition if they have been enrolled as a full-time student in the District for their <u>entire senior year</u> . A full-time student is defined as a student who earns a minimum of six (6) credits during his/her senior year. Students who were full-time students in the District their junior year and fulfilled their graduation requirements by earning fewer than six (6) credits their senior year will be eligible for scholastic recognition at the end of their senior year. <b>(Current Policy)</b> |
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**2 b Only students meeting the following criteria would be eligible for senior recognition:**

| <input type="checkbox"/> Students will be eligible for scholastic recognition if they have been enrolled within <u>the same school building</u> during his/her <u>junior and senior year.</u> | <input type="checkbox"/> Students will be eligible for scholastic recognition if they have been enrolled in <u>one school building</u> during his/her <u>entire senior year.</u> | <input type="checkbox"/> Students will be eligible for scholastic recognition if they have been enrolled as a full-time student in the District for their entire junior and senior year but not necessarily in one particular school building. |
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**3 Courses would be accepted for credit toward scholastic recognition if taught by the following instructors:**

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| <input type="checkbox"/> Only Warren County School District Instructors. | <input type="checkbox"/> Outside instructors for courses such as cyber courses and dual enrollment courses not specifically taught and assessed by a WCSD instructor. |
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**4 The number of credits that should be counted toward scholastic recognition are:**
