

WARREN STATE HOSPITAL TRAFFIC & PARKING RULES

While on Warren State Hospital Grounds, you must comply with the traffic and parking regulations. Failure to comply with any of these regulations will result in further action.

There are the rules enforced by the Hospital's Security Officers:

- Remember where you are: Warren State Hospital. Respect the dignity of our patients.
- Vehicles must stop and provide identification if requested by a Security Officer.
- Alcohol and Firearms are prohibited on State Hospital grounds.
- Pedestrians on roadways and cross walks have the Right-of-Way.
- Please, do not leave small children unattended at any time.
- Visitors, Students, and Staff must observe all posted signs.
- Posted speed limit on Hospital property is **15 miles per hour**.
- Vehicles must come to a complete, full stop at all posted STOP signs.
- All vehicles must park "front to curb"
- **Parked vehicles must have the engine shut off, keys removed from the vehicle, windows closed and all doors locked.**
- All potentially dangerous items that may be inside the vehicle must be inaccessible.
- **DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS OR ALONG THE ROADWAYS AT ANY TIME.**
- Do not park in any reserved parking areas.
- This is especially important: Do Not Park in the Forensic Parking Lot.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO CAMERAS/VIDEO CAMERAS – NO PICTURES OF ANY KIND ARE TO BE TAKEN ON WSH GROUNDS.**
